Message from Leadership

Dear Friends,

We want to express our gratitude for your unwavering support, trust, and partnership with the Jewish Federation of Greater Charlotte this year.

The October 7th terrorist attack on Israel and the ongoing Israel-Hamas war have left an indelible impact on our lives, and as we usher in the new year, we face continued challenges with the conflict showing no immediate resolution.

These distressing events underscore the critical importance of Federation's work, particularly as global and local antisemitic threats escalate, and Israel remains under attack. Despite these challenges, the Charlotte Jewish community has displayed remarkable resilience and determination in its mission to educate, strengthen, and unite against hate.

Through collaboration with beneficiary agencies, community institutions, educators, students, and business leaders, we have raised awareness about the impact of antisemitism in schools, workplaces, and daily life. The Israel-Hamas war has reinforced the gravity of our work and the power of our collective impact.

In the aftermath of October 7th, Federation has organized multiple community-building and educational events supporting Israel, including a Charlotte delegation to the Washington, DC March for Israel and an empty Chanukah table exhibit to raise awareness for the hostages still held captive by Hamas. With the generous support of donors and the dedication of our staff, our recent outreach activities have reached nearly 2,000 members of Charlotte's Jewish community. Together, our Israel Emergency Campaign has raised more than \$2.6M to support victims of terror and to respond to urgent humanitarian needs on the ground.

In addition to the Israel Emergency Campaign, our community raised \$5.8M in 2023 to address critical needs for Jews in Charlotte, Israel, and worldwide. These funds support over 70 agencies that engage Jewish youth, aid Jews in need, build Jewish identity, and promote Jewish education.

In our 2023 Community Report, you'll discover the many ways Federation has made a difference in Charlotte. The Jewish Federation of Greater Charlotte remains steadfast in fulfilling its mission as a local and global community builder and convener. With your continued support, we will maintain this momentum in 2024.

We look forward to working with you as we build a robust future for the Jewish community here in Charlotte and worldwide.

How Raizel Kahn Channels Her Advocacy as a Member of Outshine Hate Parent Education Committee

The Jewish Federation of Greater Charlotte, through its Outshine Hate initiative, established the Parent Advocacy Workshop Series at the start of the 2023-24 school year to empower parents to confront antisemitism in schools and online. To help guide these important conversations, Federation tapped five community members to form the Parent Education Committee, including Raizel Kahn, a mother of four boys.

For Raizel, serving as a member of the Parent Education Committee is about ensuring that all parents have the necessary tools to speak with their children about antisemitism and hate.

“It’s important for parents to become effective advocates for children at school,” Raizel explained. *“Understanding antisemitism and learning how to most effectively challenge it is crucial to helping empower us to build a more compassionate world.”*

The Israel-Hamas war in October underscored the importance of teaching parents ways to handle all forms of discrimination, both in the digital world and at school.

The education modules in Federation’s workshop series include sessions on the trajectory of antisemitism and how to talk to your children about it; best practices when encountering antisemitism; explanation and descriptions of the online spaces and platforms where children might encounter antisemitism; suggestions on what children should do if they face antisemitism at school; and how to report antisemitism at local schools and at the district level.

“It would be surprising to know a Jew who hasn’t experienced antisemitism, whether delivered casually or overtly,” said Raizel. *“My children have been aware of both forms of antisemitism, and my husband and I have been part of discussions with the community and school about antisemitism.”*

Raizel is hoping the Parent Education Committee’s initiatives help parents learn to better recognize antisemitism when it occurs in school or online and teaches them to understand when and how to effectively communicate with school administrators regarding antisemitic incidents. She also hopes the Federation programs will help parents facilitate a more inclusive and tolerant educational environment and increase awareness of available resources.

Jewish Federation of Greater Charlotte Ignites Renewed Community Commitment to Israel

When Hamas launched a terrorist attack on Israel on October 7th, the Jewish Federation of Greater Charlotte's mission to support Jews at home and abroad gained heightened significance. Following this appalling assault, Federation promptly launched an emergency campaign to aid Israel and address the urgent humanitarian needs on the ground.

The ensuing efforts have played a crucial role in ensuring the delivery of essential services and support to those in Israel who require it the most as the war continues to unfold.

Federation's Israel campaign also brought the local Charlotte community together through events such as a community vigil to mourn the lives lost, webinars featuring experts including Hen Mazzig and Matti Friedman, and a unity Shabbat. In November, Federation facilitated the attendance of nearly 300 Charlotte Jewish community members at the March for Israel in Washington D.C. to show support for Israel and take a stand against antisemitism. During Chanukah, Federation organized an empty Chanukah table exhibit in uptown Charlotte to raise awareness for the hostages still being held captive in Gaza and the need to bring them home now.

Through Federation's activities since October 7, Federation has engaged nearly 2,000 Charlotte community members. One of those community members is Charlotte resident Alison Lerner.

For Alison, a longtime member of Charlotte's Jewish community, the Israel-Hamas conflict has emphasized the importance of Jewish identity, solidarity, and the critical role Federation plays in helping Jews in need.

"Israel is facing attacks from every angle. The unprecedented and frightening numbers of people online and in protests calling for the destruction of the only Jewish state highlight the severity of the situation," Alison expressed. "It is the responsibility of all Jews in the diaspora to demonstrate support."

In addition to subscribing to podcasts offering daily tips to combat antisemitism and wearing hostage dog tags and Jewish jewelry, Alison has channeled her support for Israel into action by donating to Federation's Israel Emergency Campaign and attending the March for Israel.

At the end of this month, Alison will take part in a Federation delegation traveling to Washington, D.C. to lobby for Israel on Capitol Hill.

As the war in Israel enters its fourth month and antisemitic incidents continue to rise globally, Federation will continue to respond to these unprecedented challenges by educating, raising awareness, raising funds, and engaging motivated local community members like Alison to use their voice to show Charlotte's support for Israel.

The Blumenthals: A Jewish Federation of Greater Charlotte Founding Family's Legacy Today

The Blumenthal's family history in Charlotte can be traced back nearly 100 years. Patriarch I.D. Blumenthal moved to Charlotte in the 1920s and soon became actively involved in the Jewish community and greater Charlotte community. In 1939, he and other members of the local Jewish community founded the Jewish Federation of Greater Charlotte with the primary goal of helping aid Jews in Europe during the Holocaust.

I.D.'s family also established the Blumenthal Foundation in 1953 as a funding mechanism to support the Federation and ensure its programs could be continued in perpetuity. In the early days, I.D.'s brother, Herman, was a regular at Federation board meetings. Since then, subsequent generations of the Blumenthal family have remained actively involved in Federation, helping steer the organization into the future.

Today, as we continue to grapple with the global rise in antisemitism, the powerful legacy of the Blumenthal family and their far-reaching impact on Charlotte's Jewish community cannot be overlooked.

The Blumenthal Foundation is a regular contributor to the Federation's Annual Campaign, and the Blumenthals have also helped underwrite many projects and campaigns of the Federation.

Herman's sons, Alan and Philip Blumenthal, are actively involved in a variety of Jewish organizations in Charlotte and serve on the boards of numerous Jewish and secular nonprofits in the area.

The two brothers were taught from an early age that "if your community is good to you then you must be good to your community", and they live their lives accordingly.

The Blumenthal family continues to impact the Charlotte community —both Jewish and secular—through the outreach of the Blumenthal Foundation as well as with many volunteer hours.

"It's important for us to support the Jewish Federation of Greater Charlotte because of the major role it plays in our Charlotte Jewish community," said Alan and Philip Blumenthal. "The Federation is a convener that brings together our community to address the issues we face as Jews, such as the rise in antisemitism and ensuring that we have a vibrant Jewish community. Federation's support of the Charlotte Jewish community and of Israel and global Jewry cannot go unnoticed."

How Federation Inspired Gorelick Family's Legacy of Giving Back

Born to Russian immigrants who settled in Charlotte, Bill Gorelick grew up in a community that helped him understand the importance of Jewish identity. His embrace of Jewish values and traditions, and his deep connection to Charlotte's Jewish community cemented a lasting relationship with the Jewish Federation of Greater Charlotte.

Bill's involvement with Charlotte's Jewish community started at Temple Israel, where his involvement mirrored that of his parents. It was also in Charlotte where Bill met Patty, his wife for nearly 55 years until her passing in 2017. Like Bill, Patty was deeply devoted to the Charlotte Jewish community volunteering for Hadassah and spearheading the drive for women's engagement in religious rites at Temple Israel. The Gorelick family's commitment to the Federation really blossomed with Bill's leading role in the development of Shalom Park, a campus of religious, educational, and recreational facilities which became the epicenter of Jewish life in Charlotte.

"Shalom Park was a game changer because it centralized everything and made Jewish services available to everyone," Bill said. "Today the Federation is the glue that keeps the Jewish community together. The Federation supports Jewish education and works consistently with Jewish agencies to help them fulfill their goals."

At age 89, Bill serves as a trusted advisor to current leadership but has stepped into the background as his children pick up the mantle.

Today the William and Patricia Gorelick Family Foundation keeps the family legacy moving forward by providing endowments for religion, art, education, and family care. The Gorelick name can be found in many places across the city, including Levine Children's Hospital, Freedom Park, The Foundation for the Carolinas, Charlotte Country Day School, and throughout Shalom Park.

Supporting the Federation and its activities is important as "the Jewish community grows and continues to thrive," Bill notes. "Having Shalom Park as a central location has taught the community how to be one family."

His children have also dedicated their lives to the area's growing Jewish community.

His son Todd and daughter-in-law Stacy's ongoing service to the Charlotte Jewish community is their way of staying connected to their Jewish roots.

Todd was involved in Jewish youth groups in Charlotte and upon returning from college, became active in the Federation, where he served on several committees and was president from 2008 to 2010.

"The Federation serves as the voice and patron for the voiceless needs in our community that might otherwise be unheard," Todd said. "Federation is our Jewish philanthropic advisor, and we choose Federation for our largest sustaining gift." Shalom Park's conglomeration of services made it easy to establish relationships with other Jews. "It provided the opportunity to get involved at a young age," said his wife, Stacy, a lifelong community leader who helped create Federation's Bernstein Leadership program and served as Charlotte Jewish Day School president.

Like her parents, daughter Marcelle Gorelick is active in the Charlotte Jewish community. She grew up being involved with BBYO. Today, she is a Lion of Judah and has been active at Temple Israel, the Levine JCC, the Charlotte Ballet, and the Opera of the Carolinas. Marcelle supports the Federation because it “bolsters families and Jewish values abroad and at home and thus helps our warm welcoming, diverse Charlotte Jewish community shine as one of the jewels of the Queen City. It’s important to give, whether it’s time, money or appreciation. Giving is part of being human and it binds our community together.”

Rael Gorelick, another son, has served on the board of directors of Moishe House, Temple Israel, and the Jewish Federation of Greater Charlotte. He currently serves on the Board of Trustees of Charlotte Latin School.

“Seeing my parent’s involvement motivated me to get involved. I really understand Federation from my board member service and even farther back to when I was a presenter on behalf of BBYO to the Allocations Committee. My wife, Gabi and I know that Federation is the one place to donate where the community can decide where the money is needed most. And a significant portion goes to Israel.”

Rael’s dedication to the Charlotte Jewish community stems from an ingrained sense of family. “Charlotte is where I grew up and where my family is. And as close as I am with my family, the community is also like family,” Rael added.

Today, the Gorelicks continue to be involved in an array of Charlotte-based Jewish-centric organizations, including the Federation. “We learned from our parents’ example,” Todd explained. “It’s important to demonstrate our values to our kids. It’s important to teach morality.”

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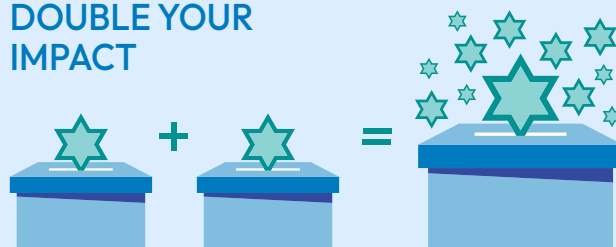
