“THE CRACKS IN THE WALL / LET THE LIGHT IN”

Since 1988, the Women of the Wall/Neshot HaKotel have led the social, legal and religious struggle for women’s rights to congregate and pray freely at the Western Wall. Despite repeated incidents of harassment, assault, and even arrest for praying with tallitot and tefillin, and carrying Torah scrolls, Women of the Wall have continued to conduct monthly women’s prayer services at the Kotel.

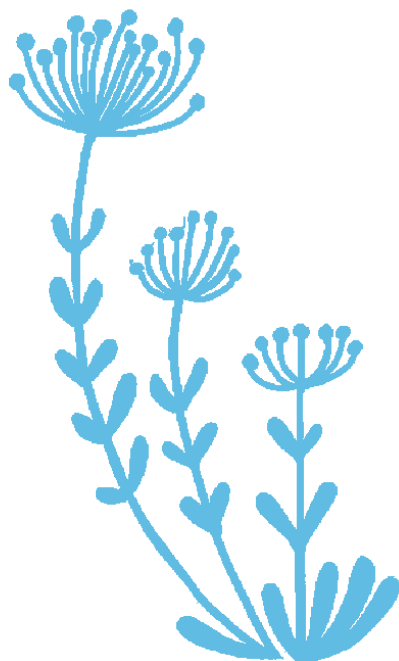
Cheryl Temkin is the North American liaison for Women of the Wall. She will take us through the extraordinary 29-year history of the movement, the changing legal and religious environment in Israel, and the challenges that still face women of all denominations who wish to pray openly at the Western Wall.
