ALSO, GRANTS ARE AWARDED BASED UPON NEED FROM THE ANNUAL CAMPAIGN, OR DONOR RECOMMENDATION. GRANTS ISSUED RANGE FROM SUMMER YOUTH CAMPERSHIPS AND SCHOLARSHIPS TO PRIVATE HIGH SCHOOLS. 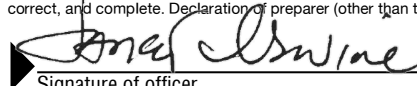
