

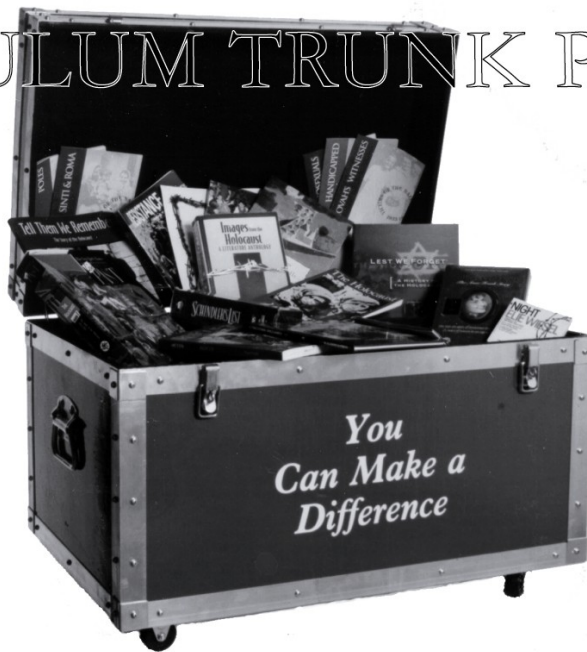

These trunks are designed to provide a comprehensive curriculum for teachers to be used in the instruction of Holocaust education in elementary, middle and high school language arts and social studies classrooms.

The concept of the trunks is to provide teachers with a working kit of multi-media tools that in most cases would be cost prohibitive to the teachers and school districts.

Curriculum trunks are loaned to requesting schools as part of an outreach program. Additionally, Florida and Houston will provide teacher training sessions on the use of the trunks, so that teachers are able to fully discuss the Holocaust and impart the important lessons from that tragic event to their students in the most effective way.

The elementary trunks are designed to be age-sensitive and teach prejudice awareness without going into the horrors of the Holocaust.

In addition, complete lesson plans and class activities are included with the accompanying videos, CDs, and posters.
