- *Q: I'm not Jewish—can I still attend?*
- A: Absolutely! We welcome non-Jewish parents who want to be effective allies and grandparents supporting their Jewish grandchildren.
- *Q: What if I'm not comfortable role-playing?*
- A: Participation in scenarios is encouraged but never required. You can observe and still benefit tremendously from seeing how others navigate these conversations.
- *Q: Will there be follow-up support after the workshop?*
- A: Yes! You'll gain access to AJC's ongoing resources, our parent network, and our team of education experts who can provide guidance as situations arise.
- *Q: My school doesn't have many Jewish students. Is this still relevant?*
- A: Very much so. The framework and communication strategies we teach are valuable for anyone advocating for inclusive, respectful school environments—and for understanding how antisemitism manifests even in schools without large Jewish populations.
- *Q: What if my child is in an interfaith family?*
- A: We have guidance for interfaith families navigating Jewish identity questions in schools. You'll find the session especially helpful for articulating your family's unique needs.
