PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Online Courses

Self-paced and facilitator-led, participants gain access to classroom content and consider instructional enhancements to support Holocaust instruction on a variety of topics. Range of 4-10 credit hours for completion.

Webinars

One-hour learning experiences, led by experts in the field, focusing on Holocaust history, teaching and learning practice, visual history testimony and digital literacy.

Live Programs

Offered both on-site and online; led by an experienced facilitator on a variety of themes and topics. Explore programs open to all educators regardless of location, as well as those developed in partnership with a district or educational community partner. Range of 2-6 credit hours.
