The successful candidate will lead Hebrew language instruction for students in Grades 3–5 and work collaboratively with our existing Hebrew/Judaica teacher to create a cohesive and engaging Hebrew and Jewish learning program across the school.

At Kehila Heschel, Hebrew is taught as a living language and as a connection to Jewish identity, culture, and community. Our instruction emphasizes immersion, joy, and practical communication, helping students develop confidence and curiosity as they engage with the language.

The successful candidate will also collaborate with our Hebrew/Judaica teacher on Jewish holiday programming, Shabbat, and other school-wide Jewish learning and celebrations.

Key Responsibilities

- Lead Hebrew language instruction for students in Grades 3–5, including speaking, listening, reading, and writing

- Collaborate closely with the school's Hebrew/Judaica teacher to develop a cohesive Hebrew and Jewish learning program

- Co-teach and contribute to programming for Jewish holidays, Shabbat, and other Jewish celebrations throughout the school year
 - Create a warm, supportive, and engaging learning environment that fosters a love of Hebrew and Jewish learning
 - Collaborate with classroom teachers to integrate Hebrew into the broader curriculum and school experience
 - Encourage student participation through conversation, stories, games, projects, and interactive learning
 - Assess and support student progress in Hebrew language development
 - Participate in school routines, including recess duty and other shared responsibilities
 - Attend staff meetings and collaborate as part of the teaching team
 - Participate actively in the broader life of the school community

- Fluency in Hebrew, both spoken and written
 - Experience teaching Hebrew, preferably with students in Grades 3–5
 - Strong knowledge of Hebrew language instruction and age-appropriate teaching practices
 - Experience working in a Jewish educational setting is an asset
 - Enthusiasm for Jewish education and a commitment to fostering a positive learning environment
 - Willingness and ability to collaborate and co-teach with another Hebrew/Judaica teacher, particularly around Jewish holidays and celebrations
 - Teaching certification or commensurate classroom qualifications or experience
 - Strong communication, organization, and interpersonal skills
 - Ability to work collaboratively with classroom teachers and school leadership
 - Comfort participating actively in the Jewish life of the school community
