2025 - 2026 Highlights

Achieved a record-breaking

\$2,817,397

Annual Campaign, marking our fifth consecutive year of campaign growth.

Grew Foundation assets to more than

\$46 Million

Strengthening our community's long-term philanthropic future.

Secured more than **\$350,000** *in nonprofit security funding, helping local Jewish organizations, synagogues, Chabads, and schools enhance their security. This includes:*

- **\$132,879** in state funding to support the Community Security Director.
- **\$75,414** in state funding for off-duty law enforcement.

*The Federation additionally secured **\$46,690** through the Tepper Grant to strengthen early childhood education security.*

- Released the findings of the Northeast Florida Jewish Community Study, providing valuable data to guide future planning and investment.
- Welcomed more than **500** attendees to the largest campaign event in Federation history, raising over **\$300,000** in support of our mission.
- Modernized our community investment model by transitioning to a hybrid allocations and grantmaking approach, increasing flexibility and strategic impact.
- Celebrated more than **40** graduates of our premier leadership programs—Young Professionals BRIDGES and Women's Philanthropy LEAD - and reached record representation on the Jewish Federations of North America's National Young Leadership Cabinet (8 members) and National Women's Philanthropy Board (8 members).
- Expanded educational outreach through the Jewish Community Relations Council, with Student to Student reaching more than **200** non-Jewish students, while Tribe Talk equipped more than **40** middle and high school students and parents with tools to recognize and respond to antisemitism.
- Strengthened relationships with local government through regular meetings with Jacksonville Mayor Donna Deegan and provided training for the Mayor's staff on the rise of contemporary antisemitism.
- Led a CommUNITY Mission to Israel that brought together Jewish and non-Jewish civic leaders, including the CEO of United Way, to foster understanding, deepen relationships, and strengthen community partnerships.
- Women's Philanthropy traveled to Mexico City, connecting with the local Jewish community and fellow Lions of Judah, further strengthening our global Jewish connections.

Provides accessible transportation for River Garden residents, helping seniors stay connected through community events, volunteering, and cultural programs while promoting independence, engagement, and meaningful relationships.

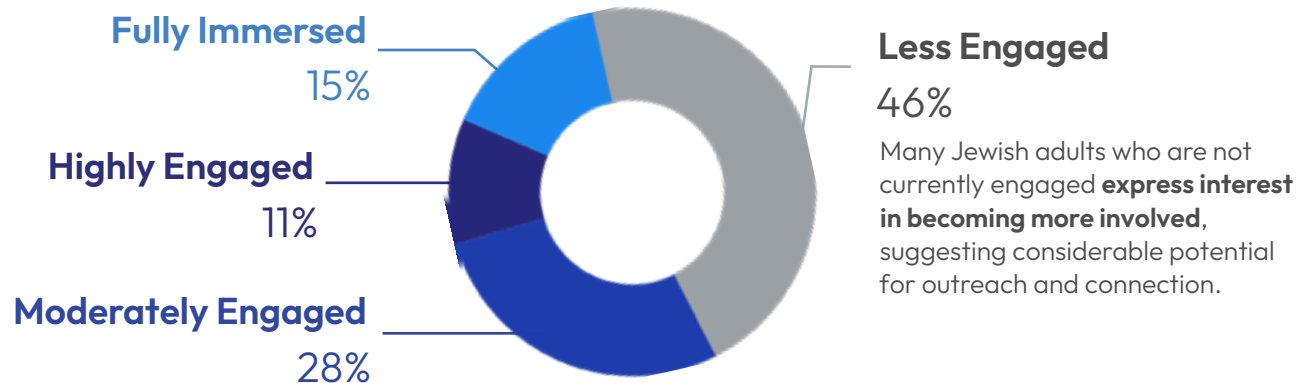

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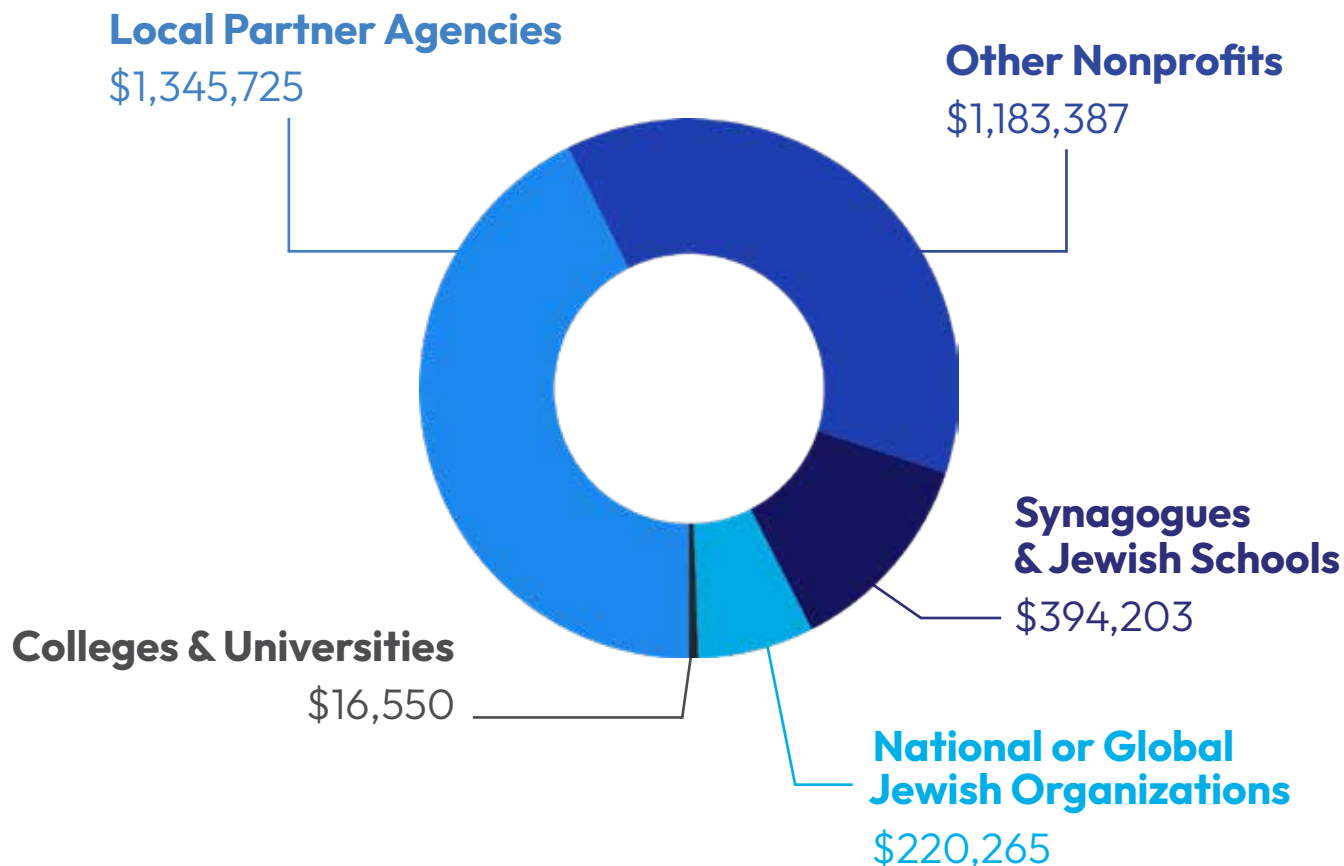
