After ongoing consultation with our team, Israeli partners, organizations across the field, and in light of the continued instability around flights, we have made the difficult decision to **reschedule your upcoming Momentum trip in April to another date in 2026.**

We understand how disappointing this is. This decision was not made lightly. The safety and well-being of our participants, partners, and staff will always guide us.

Momentum is in close communication with your local Partner Organization, and together we are working on next steps and future travel opportunities later this year. **Your payment will be held as a credit toward a future Momentum trip.**

As we approach Passover, we are reminded that even the journey out of Egypt to Israel was not a straight path. This journey is not unfolding in a straight line either, but we will get there. We believe deeply that when you do arrive in Israel, the experience will be even more meaningful and powerful.

We continue to pray for the State of Israel, for the safety of our brothers and sisters, for the IDF and U.S. troops, and for peace in the days ahead. Momentum will be closed for Passover from April 1–12.

Wishing you and your families a meaningful Passover filled with strength, freedom, and renewal.
