Israel Trip Overview and Outcomes

The 9-day travel experience captures the wonders of ancient and modern Israel as students visit key biblical sites, hear from some of the world's foremost experts on Israel's geopolitical situation, and learn about the historic and religious roots of the Christian faith.

Itinerary Highlights

- Learn about the ministry of Jesus by visiting the Mount of Beatitudes, Capernaum, and the Sea of Galilee
- Visit the hometown of Jesus in Nazareth and explore the largest church in the Middle East
- Visit Yad Vashem, Israel's Holocaust museum, and pay tribute to Israel's fallen soldiers at Mt. Herzl
- Float in the Dead Sea before heading to Jerusalem to welcome Shabbat at the Western Wall
- Visit Tel Shiloh and explore the purpose and archaeological evidence of the tabernacle
- Travel to the communities directly affected by October 7th to learn more about what locals experienced that day
- Engage in a day of advocacy by volunteering at organizations committed to aiding those impacted by the conflict
- In Jerusalem, visit the Southern Steps of the Temple Mount and explore the ancient City of David, uncovering layers of Jerusalem's rich heritage
- Visit the Mount of Olives, pray in the Garden of Gethsemane, and visit the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, the traditional site of Jesus's crucifixion

Trip Outcomes

- Passages alumni who strongly agree Israel has a right to exist and defend itself increased from **70% to 84%** after the trip
- Passages alumni who strongly agree Jesus' Jewish heritage is an important part of his story and message increased from **70% to 90%** after the trip
- Passages alumni who strongly agree antisemitism is a serious, contemporary threat to the Jewish people in their community increased from **58% to 80%** after the trip
- Passages alumni who believe Hamas is a radical Islamic terrorist organization who does not believe in Israel's right to exist as a Jewish state increased from **68% to 94%**
- **95%** say that the United States should continue to support Israel
- **90%** of alumni are involved in Passages post-trip engagement (advocacy, alumni events, serve as campus or trip fellows etc.)
