



Accessing Consulate General of Israel in Toronto Services Remotely

Many Consular Services may be done via mail or with the help of a local notary public. Below is a list of commonly requested Consular services, and instructions on how to access them remotely.

The Following commonly requested services may be completed via registered mail:

Passport Renewal for Minors in Western Canada

At this time the Consulate is now asking the minor's renew their passport in front of the consulate in-person. [Click here](#), for more information.

The Consul's new policy is that you may have your documents signed by any local notary; no longer limited to the notary's listed on the Consul website. However, you must have your documents authenticated by Official Documents and Appointments Alberta after they have been signed by a notary. After your forms are notarized and authenticated, the signed forms and passport photos must be sent by mail to the Consulate General of Israel in Toronto.
