## Anti-Semitism

This committee strives to understand modern Anti-Semitism and address Anti-Semitic instances in our community and across the world.



## PJ Library

PJ Library provides free books to Jewish children ages 0-9 across the world! The CUJF serves as the community touchpoint for PJ Library books, as well as for Jewish children and family programming.



## Campaign

As a 501(c)(3) organization, we depend on our campaign to help financially support the many things that the CUJF does. Our annual campaign is a year long process with events and marketing.



## Chevra Kadisha

The Chevra Kadisha, the local Jewish burial society, provides preparation of the dead for traditional Jewish burial, education about Jewish death and mourning practices, and respectful, low-cost burial for the indigent.



## CHAI Seniors

Each month, our seniors program holds a luncheon, lecture, or other social events. These are usually related to a Jewish topic, or shared by a Jewish community member.



## Human Services

The human services committee addresses urgent individual needs, visits sick community members, and provides financial support for many causes.



## Events

We are fortunate to hold many types of events throughout the year. This includes our involvement in Uniting Pride’s Annual Pride Fest and Parade, booths at the Champaign farmers market, artists in residence, and more!
