I would fight for freedom and independence for me and future generations.

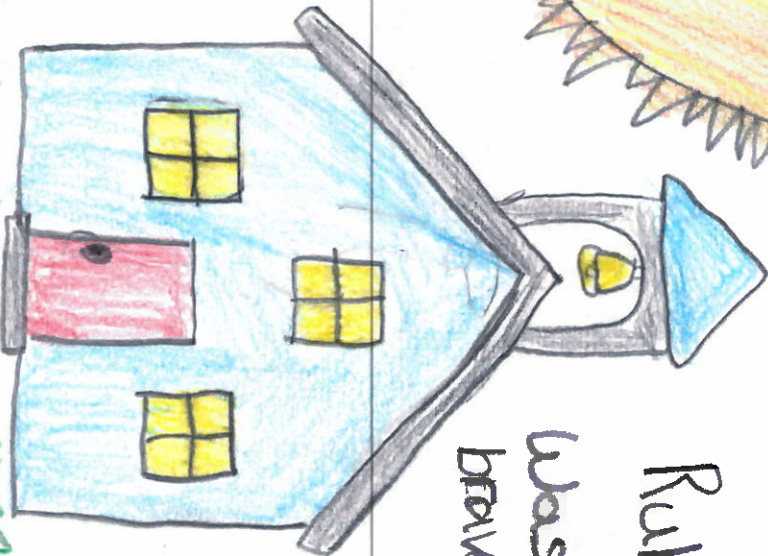
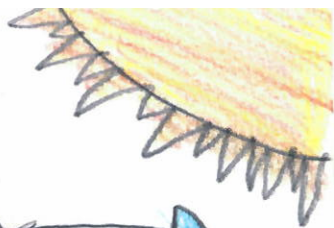
