

# POOL RULES

**NO** Breath holding, running, diving, squirt guns, gum, horseplay, glass (including goggles), alcohol, smoking, vaping, monofins, inflatables, or hanging on lane lines

Children under 14 years of age will not be allowed at the pool without adult supervision.

A 25-yard, lifeguard-administered swim test is mandatory for all children younger than 12 who would like to swim in the deep end of the main pool independently. No exceptions. Once passed, each child will be given a wristband to be kept visible at all times to be allowed in the deep end. **This swim test must be done every day the child is in the pool. If a wristband is lost or removed on the day it was given, the swim test must be retaken.**

Proper swim attire is required; no cut off shorts or basketball shorts allowed. Family-friendly swim trunks and bathing suits only. No thongs or string bikinis permitted.

Adults must watch their child(ren) at all times. An adult must always be present when their child is in the pool.

Any child who cannot stand or swim on their own without the support of a life jacket must always be within arm's reach of an adult.

Only United States Coast Guard approved & certified life jackets are allowed in the pool.

Children over 8 years of age are not permitted in the small pool.

All children under 4 years of age, AND any child who has been potty trained for less than one full year, must be **double covered** in the pool at all times: the first layer must be a disposable swim diaper OR a reusable swim diaper, and the second layer must be a Happy Nappy snug-fitting reusable swim cover. A bathing suit may be worn over the Happy nappy cover if you choose. **If the double coverage policy is ignored and a pool closure occurs, you will be fined \$500 for the incurred costs as a result of a pool closure.**

Children must change clothes in a locker room, not on the pool deck.

Swim diapers must be disposed of in the locker rooms.

Kickboards and noodles are for swim lessons, Aqua fitness, or lap swimmers only. (Members are allowed to bring their own.) No standing or sitting on kickboards.

Swim lesson students are only allowed in the pool when their instructor is in the pool. If the instructor has not arrived, students must wait on the pool deck.

No glassware, squirt guns, or mono fins (mermaid fins) allowed.

Persons with open wounds, sores, infectious conditions (colds, flu, fever) will not be allowed in the pool.

Foul or abusive language will not be tolerated.

Unwanted touching of another adult or child is strictly prohibited. Respect personal space.

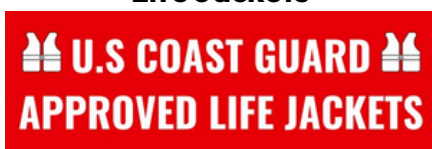
Lanes are designated for lap swimming only. Do not cut through or go over the lane lines. Lanes must be shared; If more than 2 people are using the lane, a circle pattern must be adopted.

Lifeguards always have final discretion regarding all pool activity.

Safety breaks will be called at the top of the hour during recreational/open swim. Safety breaks will be 10 minutes in length. ALL swimmers must exit the pool, use the restroom, reapply sunscreen, and hydrate.
