As the Weinberg Jewish Federation Campus enters its eighteenth year, we are making great strides in maintaining the building which houses our community agencies, including the Jewish Federation and Jewish Community Foundation, the Alpert Jewish Community Center, Jewish Family and Children's Service, and the Long Beach Hillel. Over the past 18 years the campus has also hosted numerous events for community organizations and synagogues. It truly has become a center of Jewish life in the Greater Long Beach area.

Over the past year we have increased our efforts to ensure the facility's long-term viability.

Facilities Management; Contracted with AAA Companies to provide on-site maintenance services, reducing labor costs, and addressing the growing maintenance needs of our aging systems.

Long-Term Planning; Created a 10 year projection of campus maintenance needs in order to better plan for facility upgrades, as they are needed.

Roof & Solar System Project; With the help of local investors and donors, we will invest \$2 MILLION in the replacement of the roof and installation of parking lot and roof top solar panels. This investment will save the community and our partner agencies millions of dollars over the 25 year lifespan of the system.

Subfloor Replacement; \$200,000 was invested in replacing the subfloor in the fitness, JFCS and youth wing hallways and classrooms.

Lighting Upgrades; Began a full-campus conversion from general lighting to LED, which will reduce operating costs and positively impact the environment.

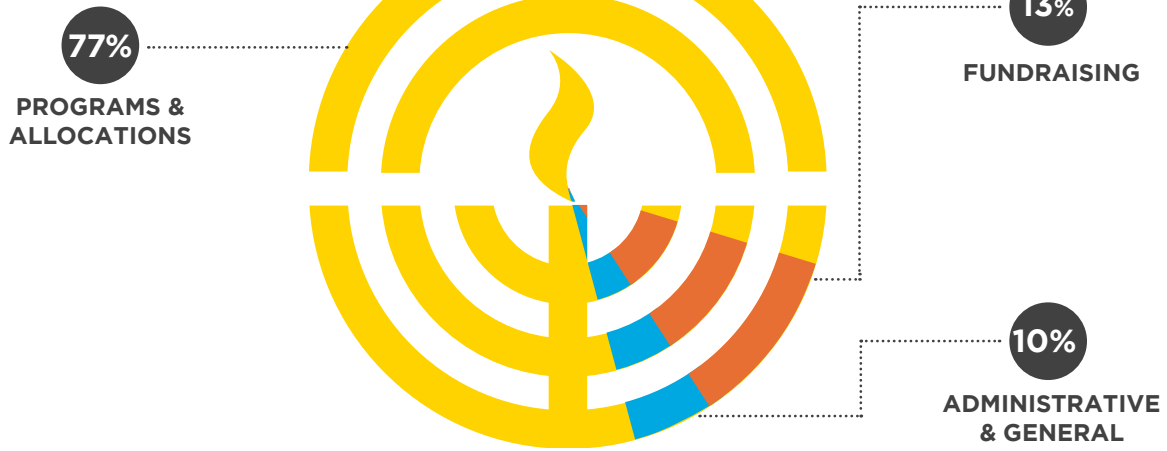

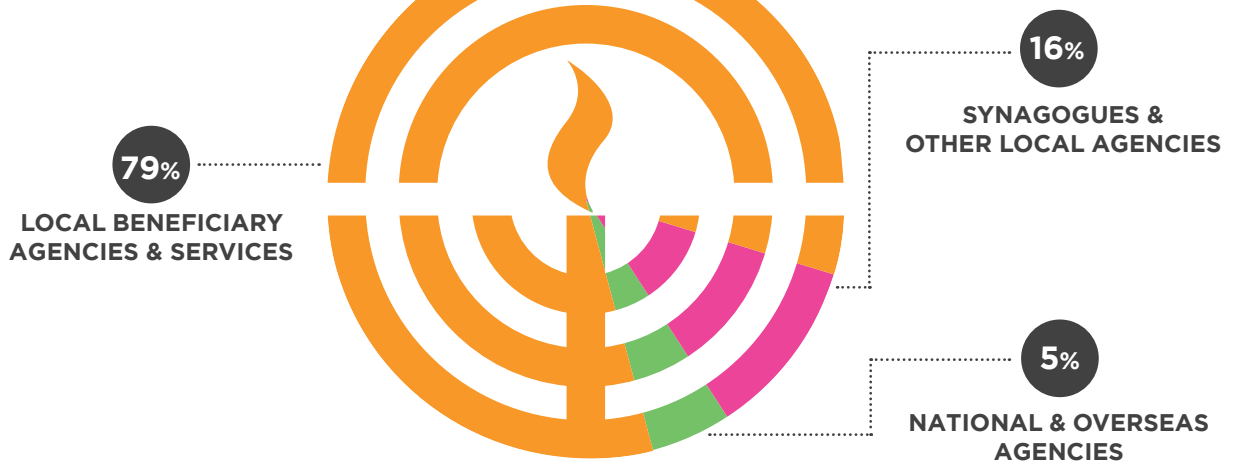

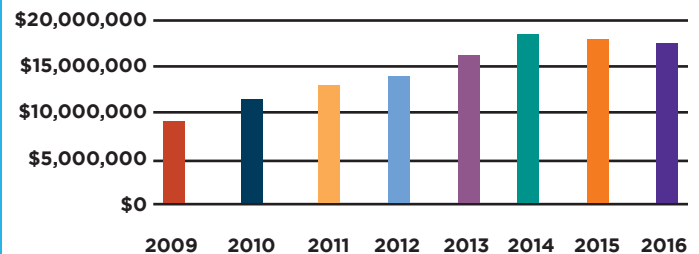
