Therefore, it is resolved:

Laura K. Linder, President and CEO of Jewish Community Partners, Laura Kaplan, Vice President of Finance and Operations, and Sheri Gadberry, Executive Vice President and Senior Philanthropic Officer, have authority to sign any document on behalf Jewish Foundation of Memphis in the following instances:

- Creating and updating bank accounts for fund holders and support organizations.
- Signing any contract within the scope of the approved budget.
- Legal and compliance documents required to maintain tax status.
- Applications for additional funding to support our charitable purpose.

Any situations that fall outside the scope of this resolution will be presented to the Chair and when applicable, brought to the board for approval. No material changes to the organization's financial status shall be made without board approval.

By affirmative votes noted as the signature below, a majority vote of the members Jewish Foundation of Memphis with authority to bind the company approves the form and content of this resolution to be effective immediately.

New Partner Agency Expansion Proposal
March 16, 2023
Board of Directors Meeting

The Expansion Committee consisted of Ronald Harkavy, Steve Wishnia, Wendy Rotter, Jason Salomon, Laura Linder. The Committee met on January 26, 2022 at the law offices of Harkavy Shainberg Kaplan PLC.

Recommendation:

It is proposed by the Expansion Committee that the Jewish Foundation of Memphis Board of Directors approve opening up the Foundation to new partner agencies with the following conditions:

- 1) \$10,000 buy-in per year for 10 years (fee may be prorated if the organization is approved in the middle of a fiscal year) unless otherwise altered by the Board of Directors;
- 2) After 10 years agency is eligible for fee reduction unless otherwise altered by the Board of Directors;
and
- 3) Organization must be based in Memphis/midsouth, be Jewish in its focus/practice, have local paid staff, active lay leadership and have a physical office/building. Service area exclusive to Memphis/midsouth.

New partner agencies will be eligible for full membership benefits, including:

- 1) Access to JFOM programs (e.g. Life and Legacy, Life and Legacy Plus)
- 2) Inclusion in the JFOM Needs list that is sent to fund holders
- 3) Partner agency fund administrative fees for custodial assets invested with JFOM's platform (10 bp vs 50 bp)
- 4) One appointee to the JFOM board of directors
- 5) Annual endowment/legacy training for their board of directors
- 6) Endowment solicitation support

Prospective agencies will be invited to join by the Board of Directors as recommended by the staff.

Organizations wishing to join may apply via a formal letter, signed by the Executive Director and Chair of the Board of Directors. Included with the letter of application will be a copy of the board meeting minutes indicating approval of all membership criteria by its board of directors.

Organizations must agree to be bound by all of the terms and provisions of the Bylaws of the Jewish Foundation of Memphis, as amended from time to time.

A quorum of the board of directors of the Jewish Foundation of Memphis will be required for a vote to occur. A majority of the board members present will be required for the approval of any applicant organization.

Partner Agency Support

JFOM Partner Agencies receive customized support depending on their goals and needs. This can include:

- Assistance with developing an endowment fundraising infrastructure (e.g. policy development, strategy, trainings, goal setting, prospect development, etc.);
- Personalized endowment education (e.g. special presentations by JFOM staff to your sisterhoods, senior groups, parent groups, board of directors, etc.);
- Preparation of marketing materials on all aspects of planned giving and endowments including gift illustrations, press releases, information on giving strategies, newsletter articles, etc.;
- Assistance with the identification, cultivation and solicitation of endowment prospects;
- Inclusion in Jewish Foundation publications;
- Opportunity to submit quarterly list of grant opportunities to be shared with Donor Advised Fund holders;
- Technical support in all areas of charitable gift planning including life income trusts, life insurance, retirement benefits, limited partnership interests, etc.
- Access to special grant opportunities and programs of the Foundation such as Create Your Jewish Legacy, Jewish Funders Network Matching Grants initiatives, etc.
- Assistance in identifying grant opportunities with local, regional and national foundations and with writing grant proposals;
- Assistance with complex or unusual gifts including gifts of real estate and other illiquid assets;
- Access to the Foundation's Investment platform and a position on the investment committee;

In order to benefit from the JFOM/Agency partnership, Partner Agencies should make a commitment to:

- Attend JFOM's quarterly board meetings (this includes the three appointed board members and the Executive Director/CEO of the Partner Agency);
- Appoint three people to the board of directors who:
 - Understand the importance of endowment giving and its effect on the financial stability of the community;
 - Are in a position to discuss mission and goals of the Foundation with others (either formally or informally);
 - Is well-known by constituents of your organization;
 - Plays or has played a prominent role in your organization;
 - Is in a position to communicate the Foundation's activities and opportunities to your organization as well as relate your needs to the Foundation.
- Regularly communicate with the Foundation, through written notice, emails, sharing of meeting minutes, etc., the needs and priorities of your organization as well as any realized bequest or endowment contributions;
- Consult with the Foundation on prospects targeted for major gift development in order to gather information that could aid in developing a thoughtful approach to donors;
- Develop (with the Foundation's assistance, if needed) a communications plan to actively promote the importance of endowment and planned giving with leadership, major supporters and through organization publications;
- Involve the Foundation in all major fundraising initiatives in order to determine where natural partnerships exist and collaboration would be of benefit in maximizing the outcome.
