

Family Emergency Supply Kit

Every household member should have an **Emergency Supply Kit** – a collection of items you may need during an evacuation – packed in an easy-to-carry container such as a backpack. Below is a suggested list of items to include in your emergency supply kit.

What to Include?

- ✓ Copies of documents in a waterproof and portable container (photo IDs, insurance cards, etc.)
- ✓ Cash, change for a pay phone, ATM/credit cards
- ✓ Cell phone for texting, charger
- ✓ Extra set of house/car keys
- ✓ Bottled water, one gallon of water per person per day, for drinking and sanitation
- ✓ Non-perishable food (canned goods), ready-to-eat canned meats, fruits and vegetables
- ✓ Can opener for food (if kit contains food)
- ✓ First aid kit
- ✓ Medications & non-prescription drugs
- ✓ Doctors' names and phone numbers
- ✓ Eyewear: reading glasses, contact lenses supplies
- ✓ Battery-powered radio and a NOAA Weather Radio with tone alert, extra batteries for both
- ✓ Flashlight, extra batteries
- ✓ Whistle to signal for help
- ✓ Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation
- ✓ Dust mask or cotton t-shirt, to help filter the air
- ✓ Child care (infant formula & diapers), pet care (food & litter) and etc
- ✓ Contact & meeting place info for your household & a small local map
- ✓ **Carrying your supply kit: Make prior arrangements for assistance with carrying your supplies kit and/or arrange for transportation.**



NOTE:

The 72-Hour Rule

Have **at least a three-day supply** of water, food and medicine.

Remember to include medical devices & food for your dietary needs
