My painting symbolizes peace between Israeli and Arabs by showing an Israeli and Arab soldier praying for unity and peace at the Western wall.



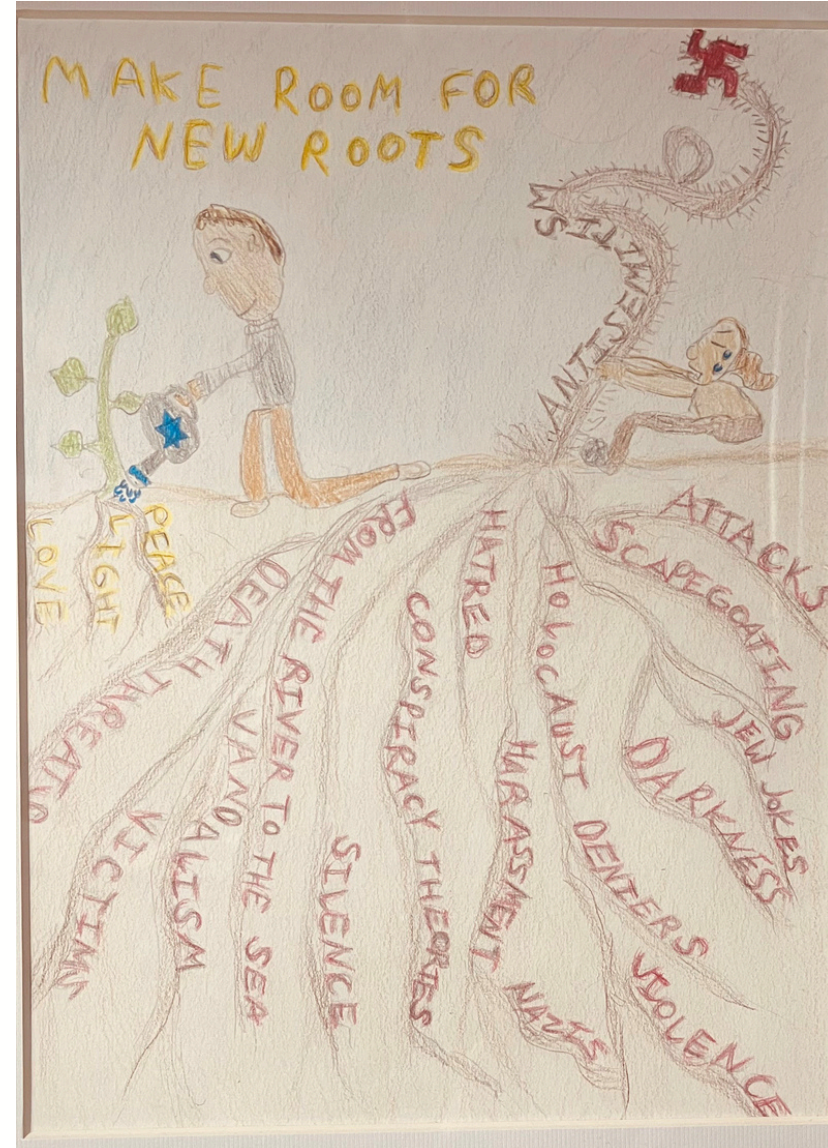
PRIMARY DIVISION

Artist Statement:

Most people understand that a swastika is antisemitic, but there are many other types of antisemitism that people might not be aware of. 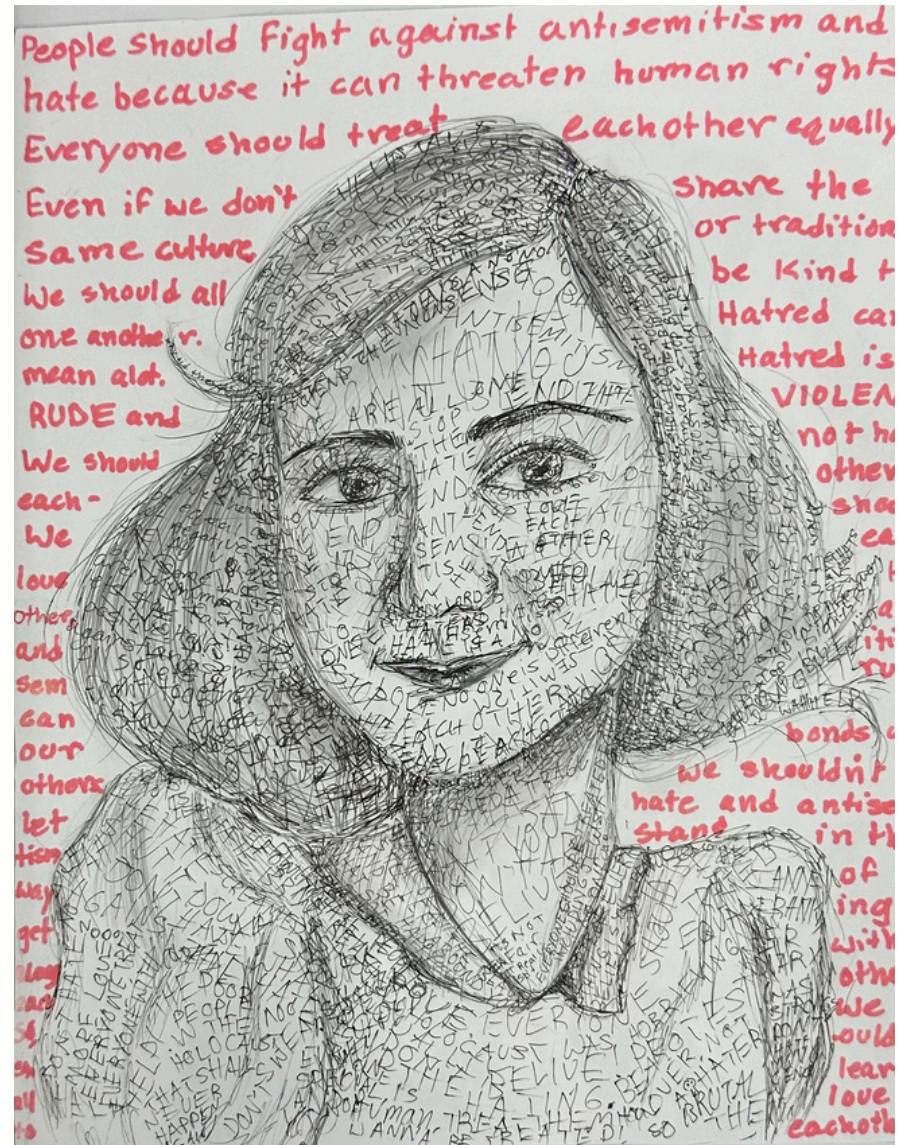


PRIMARY DIVISION
